Research Interests

First, I explore **gamified urban design methodologies**, utilizing computational tools and interactive simulations to enhance participatory planning and data collection.

Second, I investigate the technical and social dimensions of **bicycle-centric urbanism**, integrating performance metrics such as Bicycle Level of Service (BLOS) and Multi-Modal Level of Service (MMLOS) with the theoretical framework of "generalized speed". This research examines the nexus of energy expenditure, infrastructure safety, and the unique socio-cultural drivers of bicycle lifestyles, exemplified by Japan's mamachari culture.

Third, I conduct research on **community-making** through the lens of third-place revitalization, specifically exploring the potential of "combini cafés" as nodes for social cohesion.
